(Formerly Foundations of Fetal Heart Monitoring)

FORMAT: Self-paced interactive CD-ROM **CEs/CMEs:** TBD/none
PREREQUISITE: Less than six months of fetal monitoring experience

This CD-ROM introduces the learner to the maternal-placental-fetal system, auscultation, electronic fetal monitoring, fetal heart rate changes, as well as a new section on documentation and risk management. Self-assessment materials and a CE application are included.

Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course
(Formerly Fetal Heart Monitoring Principles and Practices Program or FHMPP)

FORMAT: Two day in-person course **CEs/CMEs:** 18.3/15.25
PREREQUISITE: Minimum of six months of fetal monitoring experience

Intermediate FMC is designed to enhance and validate the knowledge and skills of experienced health care professionals. The course offers demonstration, practice, and testing of the following skills: auscultation, performing Leopold's Maneuvers, placement of an intrauterine pressure catheter and spiral electrode, tracing interpretation, identification of indicated intervention, communication and documentation.

FHM Competence Assessment
(Formerly FHMPP Knowledge Review and Assessment)

FORMAT: Self-paced on-line assessment **CEs/CMEs:** none
PREREQUISITE: Successful completion of Intermediate FMC

This case scenario-based tool is designed to assess the critical thinking skills involved in fetal assessment and surveillance during the antepartum and intrapartum periods.

PASS

Student may retake annually or proceed to Advanced FMC.

FAIL

AWHONN recommends that the student review the assessment and FHM text, and retake the Intermediate FMC.

Advanced Fetal Monitoring Course
(Formerly Advanced FHMMP or AFHMPP)

FORMAT: One day in-person course **CEs/CMEs:** 11.9/10.0
PREREQUISITE: Successful completion of Intermediate FMC and one year of fetal monitoring experience

Advanced FMC content builds on the essential knowledge and skills gained through Intermediate FMC. The course uses a case study approach that focuses on the analysis of more complex FHM patterns, characteristics and related case information. The course also emphasizes maternal-fetal physiology, interpretation, intervention, communication skills and risk management strategies.

Fetal Monitoring Instructor Course (FMIC)
(Formerly Instructor Enhancement Course)

FORMAT: One day in-person course **CEs/CMEs:** 8.7/none
PREREQUISITE: Meets AWHONN criteria for Instructor Candidates (see www.awhonn.org/fhm)

FMIC prepares participants to teach Intermediate FMC by focusing on the principles of adult learning and the application of these principles. Participants discuss the role and responsibilities of the instructor, workshop administrative procedures, and basis for workshop content development.
