

## ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The purpose of the two-day AWHONN Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course is to promote integration of knowledge and skills essential to assessment, promotion and evaluation of fetal well-being during labor.

The focus is on the physiological basis for fetal heart monitoring and on assessment, interpretation, management and evaluation of fetal heart rate patterns as well as the importance and relationship of communication, collaboration and documentation in promoting patient safety.

In the skills component of the course, the learner will have the opportunity to practice and demonstrate skills in fetal heart rate auscultation, nursing responsibilities for and application of fetal spiral electrodes and intrauterine pressure catheters and communication and documentation of fetal heart rate monitoring data.
